Virtual Programming for Club Members: Parental Consent Form

Dear Parent/Guardian:

In an effort to continuously serve members during the Club closure, Boys & Girls Club of Greater Shasta is providing distance-based, virtual programming for Club members, through which Club staff will facilitate program activities through online platforms. Boys & Girls Club of Greater Shasta will use software, tools and applications provided by **Zoom**, a third party that members, parents/guardians and/or staff will access via the Internet and use for purposes of communication and programming.

This letter seeks consent for your child to utilize Zoom for distance-based, virtual Club program purposes. Zoom complies with global privacy frameworks and have implemented data protection and privacy practices into their products and processes. Zoom's Privacy Team is responsible for the management and development of Zoom's external and internal privacy programs, ensuring compliance with US and international privacy regulations, and evaluating the privacy practices of their suppliers. Please be aware that each application collects different information about its users and has its own privacy terms and conditions to which members must adhere. Please review these carefully before registering your member.

In order to participate in virtual Club programming, you will need to do the following:

- Each participant will need to have this permission slip completed and emailed back to us at info@bgcgreaterashasta.org
- In order to participate in a program, registration is required. You may find our program calendar and registration links here: bgcgreaterashasta.org/virtualprogramming.
- Club members will need access to a computer that has a webcam and microphone, or the use of a cellphone with the same features.
- Zoom will need to be downloaded to each participant's desktop/mobile device.

We will use the online applications for the following program activities:

- Club Programs such as Power Hour homework help, and STEAM, which will include group chats, video conferencing, sharing projects, etc.

Our commitment to keeping the young people we serve safe is always our number one priority. Boys & Girls Club of Greater Shasta will actively monitor member activity on Zoom and will make every effort to protect member information by, among other things, maintaining control of, and access to, the data collected; prohibiting re-disclosure of member information; limiting the purposes for which the online platforms may use member information; ensuring there is no advertising and that no member information is collected for commercial purposes.

Further, all activities online must comply with Boys & Girls Club of Greater Shasta's safety policies.
